**District 14B - Policy No. 317**

**Policy to Define the Duties of the District Parliamentarian**

PURPOSE: A Lion who has as knowledge of the Constitution and By-Laws of Lions Clubs International, Multiple District 14, District 14-B, the district policy manual and Robert's Rules of Order.

GENERAL:

He/she shall be a Lion in good standing in a Lions Club and act under the supervision of the District Governor

The specific responsibilities shall be to:

- a. Have knowledge of parliamentary procedures including but not limited to, order of precedence for motions (Privileged, Subsidiary and Main) and interpretation of the rules and parliamentary procedures.
- b. Have a good knowledge of the District 14-B Constitution and By-Laws and policy manual;
- c. Have the authority to request the District Governor or the presiding officer to allow interpretation of any ruling or question concerning a Constitutional and By-laws, policy question;
- d. Attend all district cabinet meetings where a policy or amendments may be voted upon to affect the action of the cabinet or Lions clubs within the district.
