DISTRICT 13 OH3 CONVENTION DELEGATE REGISTRATION - 2023

Dear Club President and or Secretary:

According to the Constitution & By-Laws of Ohio Lions Inc. and the International Association of Lions Clubs, the election of district officers shall be conducted by secret ballot. To ensure a secret ballot and that only authorized delegates, clubs and delegates cast ballots, delegates must comply with the following rules:

- Each Club is entitled to one (1) delegate for every ten (10) members or major fraction thereof, that 1. have been enrolled in the Club for at least one year and a day as of February 28, 2023. It is the duty of each Club to send a full delegation to the District Convention.
- 2. All Past District Governors of District 13 OH3 shall be considered Delegates-At-Large to this Convention, in addition to the delegate quota of your Club. Any delegate shall have but one vote on each question or issue that is submitted to this Convention.
- The Club must be in good financial standing with Lions International and District 13 OH3. All dues must 3. be current.
- This form, listing delegates, MUST BE COMPLETED, SIGNED, AND RETURNED to the CABINET 4. SECRETARY, by the Club Secretary, on or before April 10, 2023.
- Each delegate must be a member in good standing with your Club and must pick up his or her authorization 5. to receive a ballot for the business session from the Registration/Certification Desk, prior to 9:00 AM on Saturday April 22nd.
