Appreciation!

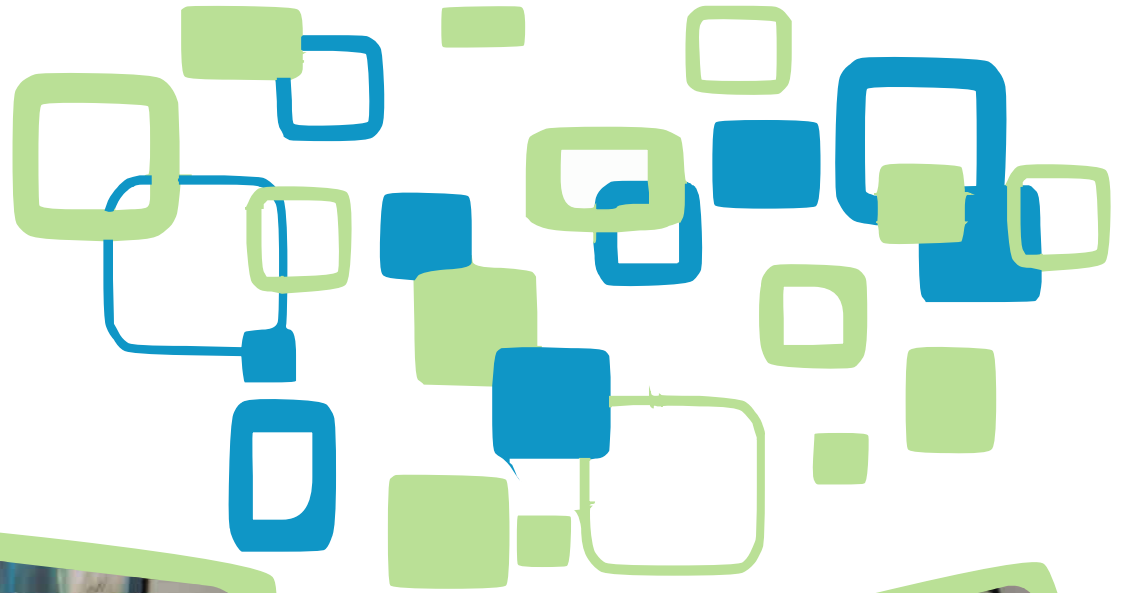
