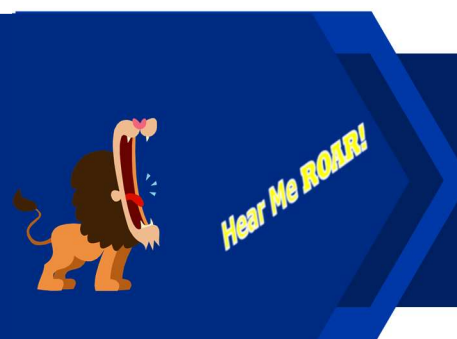


## Thinking of a New Box
