Redistricting Grant
NYS & Bermuda Lions Foundation Grant - Camp Abilities Saratoga

PCC Mark Whitney presented information for the use of the redistricting grant. The grant request is for \$2880 from LCI

PDG Jim Shaw made a motion to apply for the grant, Lion Diane Chanowsky 2^{nd} the motion. DG Michele called for a vote, everyone was in favor, and motion was carried.

IPDG John McDonald presented information to request a grant from the NYS & Bermuda Lions Foundation. The grant would be used for Camp Abilities to help fund camper expenses for the camp. The request is for a matching funds grant of \$5,000.

Foundation Trustee PDG Jim Shaw spoke up and said that there needs to be 2 years in between receiving grants from the Foundation. He was under the impression that Camp Abilities received a grant in consecutive years before being rejected a year ago. He felt that there may be a need to wait another year before CAS can apply again. Upon discussion the determination was made that the grant application would be approved conditionally for CAS to move forward upon PDG Jim determining CAS's eligibility with Foundation President Rich Steger. If ineligible to proceed on their own, CAS would proceed through the support of the District.

PDG Paula Flisnik made a motion that District 20 W support the proposal as presented for a grant from the NYS & Bermuda Lions Foundation to support Camp Abilities, Lion Bob Pandori 2nd the motion. DG Michele called for a vote, everyone was in favor, and motion was passed.
