**MINUTES OF THE FIRST CABINET MEETING 20-W 2019-2020  
SATURDAY, SEPTEMBER 28, 2019  
PLATTSBURGH BREWING COMPANY AT THE COMFORT INN**

**I. Attendance:** See attached.

**II. Meeting Called to Order:** DG (District Governor) Lion Ed Pike called the meeting to order at 9:34 AM.

**III. Pledge of Allegiance** was led by PDG (Past District Governor) Lion Jim Shaw.

**IV. The Lions Prayer** was led by PDG Lion Joan Scott.

**V. Welcome:** President/KL (King Lion) Dennis Hulbert welcomed all the Lions to Plattsburgh. The Plattsburgh was chartered September 25, 1939. They will be celebrating their 80<sup>th</sup> charter this coming spring. He proceeded to talk about the many things their club does for their community. For example: The Lions weeded and mulched Culver Hill Park this fall sold strawberry shortcakes at the local parade to raise money, collect glasses and hearing aids, etc.

### **VI. Cabinet Business:**

- A. Cabinet Secretary:** DG Lion Ed thanked CS (Cabinet Secretary) Lion Barbara Bentley for becoming the Cabinet Secretary for 2019-2020.
- B. March 23, 2019 Cabinet Minutes 2018-2019:** DG Lion Ed asked for a motion to accept the Minutes from the March 23, 2019 Cabinet Meeting. PDG Lion Jim Shaw made the motion to accept the minutes. PDG Lion Paula Flisnik seconded it. DG Lion Ed called for a vote and the motion unanimously passed.
- C. Treasurer's Report and 2019-2020 Budget:** CT (Cabinet Treasurer) Lion Eric Unislawski presented the Treasurer's Report **see attached**. DG Lion Ed asked for a motion to accept the Treasurer's Report. PDG Lion Joan Scott made the motion to accept the report. Lion ZC (Zone Chair) Lion Florence Brisee seconded it. DG Lion Ed called for a vote and the motion unanimously passed. CT Lion Eric Unislawski presented the Budget for 2019-2020 **see attached**. He stated that it has not changed since the May 2019 meeting. PCC (Past Council Chair) Mark spoke about how the budget supports and reflects in the funds allocated from our district to train Lions now and for in the future. PCC Lion Mark said we have 3 vacancies for the Lions Leadership Institute and we are

working on getting those applications filled. **Schedule for the Zone Chairperson Training Workshop – October 19<sup>th</sup> see attached.** DG Lion Ed asked for a motion to accept the 2019-2020 Budget for 20-W. IPDG (Immediate Past District Governor) Lion Michele O'Hare made the motion to accept the budget. 3VDG (3<sup>rd</sup> Vice District Governor) Lion Rick Laurin seconded it. DG Lion Ed called for a vote and the motion unanimously passed.

- D. 2VDG (2<sup>nd</sup> Vice District Governor) Vacancy:** PCC Lion Mark Whitney stated that the team in 2018-2019 made an extensive search for a 2VDG for District 20-W for 2019-2020. We were able to have 3VDG Rick Laurin fill this slot and found many Lions who while they could not commit now were interested in the future filling a leadership role in the District. He states the qualifications to be 2VDG: (1) be an active member in good standing of a chartered Lions Club in good standing in his/her or sub-district. (2) secure the endorsement of his/her club or majority of the clubs in his/her single or sub-district. (3) Have served or will have served at the time he/she takes office as second vice district governor: (a) As president of a Lions club for a full term or major portion thereof, and a member of the board of directors of a Lions club for no less than two additional years; and (b) As zone chairperson or region chairperson or cabinet secretary and/or treasurer for a full term or major portion thereof. (c) With none of the above being accomplished concurrently. DG Lion Ed asked if there were any nominations from the floor. PDG Lion Paula Flisnik nominated IPDG Lion Michele O'Hare and PCC Mark Whitney seconded the motion. PDG Dave Ramsey wanted sad that is not uncommon to have Lions serve two terms as DG. In 20-Y2 there are two Lions that served two terms as DG. DG Lion Ed asked for a motion to close nomination. PDG Lion Dave Ramsey made a motion to close nominations and PDG Lion Joan Scott seconded the motion. DG Lion Ed called for a vote and the motion unanimously passed. PCC Lion Mark Whitney said a quorum of the Cabinet is 14 and we have a quorum made up of: DG Lion Ed, VDG Lion Rick Brisee, CS Lion Barbara Bentley, IPDG Lion Michele O'Hare, CT Lion Eric Unislawski, ZC Lion Ed Moore and ZC Lion Florence Brisee. DG Ed asked for a vote to accept the nomination of IPDG Lion Michele to be 2VDG for 2019-2020 for District 20-W and it unanimously passed. **Paper work attached.**

**VII. Warm up Icebreaker and DG Lion Ed message, cabinet meetings and visitations:** DG Lion Ed broke the Lions into three groups and they were given shoe boxes with various things inside them. The task was to see who could make the tallest tower. Lion Scott Rager, Lion Karen Rager, CT Lion Eric Unislawski and Lion Elizabeth Marzano built the highest tower. DG Lion Ed asked everyone what they thought of the exercise. The Lions felt it was a great team building exercise. DG Lion Ed said we stayed within our groups, there was no reason we couldn't have gone from group to group to work together, just like our Clubs that stay within in their own communities and should work together especially in their zones. DG Lion Ed proceeded to tell a story of his trip to Italy and at various points of his trip felt some anxiety and when you have someone who helps you and take care of details it takes away your anxiety. His theme is "Working on the Future Together". He said if we break it down to the simple elements it will be easier for our Lions to understand. We do not always work together, but we need to do this. We need to

make membership fun. Everyone needs to feel that they can participate at meetings and during projects. DG Lion Ed cabinet meetings will be focused on a subject. See attached list. His visitations will be open discussions. He will send the Presidents/KL of the Clubs ideas that they can talk about and there will have an open discussion with the members of that Club. DG Lion Ed visitation list see attached.

**VIII. Grants, Donations and Contributions:**

- A. LCIF Grants PDG Lion Paula Flisnik – See Attached** In addition Now that we raised the District has raised over \$10,000 we have \$15,000 that Clubs can apply for.
  - B. NYS & Bermuda Foundation Grants PDG Lion Jim Shaw – See Attached.** One way money is raised for the Foundation is through the Raffle tickets that is drawn at the MD-20 State Convention. 3 tickets for \$300 will allow you to receive a Robert J. Uplinger Award. These grants need District approval at a cabinet meeting. 20-W sold over 100 tickets in 2018-2019 and the District received a check for \$1,000 and another for \$500. Tickets will be coming out in October.
  - C. Brandel-Murphy Youth Foundation Grants – VDG (Vice District Governor) Lion Rick Brisee – See attached.** The grant is a one page application and only needs Club approval with the DG signature. All projects have to be attached to a Club. The major fundraiser for these Youth grants is the Super Bowl Raffle.
  - D. Miscellaneous Grants - IPDG Lion Michele O'Hare See Attached.** If your club is not 501C3 partner with another Club or a community organization and let them be the lead on your grant.
- IX. District Convention –** DG Lion Ed announced that 20-W District Convention will be Saturday, November 9, 2019. It will be at the Holiday Inn Resort Lake Gorge, 223 Canada Street, US 9, Lake George. 9:00A.M. Registration \$30/pp Includes Buffet Lunch. It will center on Childhood Cancer and the Keynote Address Lions International Director (ID) Judge Christopher Shea Nickell.
- X. 50/50** was \$110 with \$55 going to Lion Scott Rager.

**XI. Adjournment:** A motion was made by PDG Lion Jim Shaw to adjourn the meeting and was seconded by PDG Lion Paula Flisnik. DG Lion Ed called for a vote and the motion unanimously passed.
