

How do you organize a Leo Club?

Log onto Lions Clubs International website and search “Leos” www.Lionsclub.org

School –based or Community –based?

Depending upon who will be the Leo Club Advisors, decide which type you want to be. A community based one works well, just keep in mind that there are other activities in middle or high schoolers lives that may prevent them from attending every meeting or community service event.

What does it cost?

Lions Club sponsors pay a one-time fee of \$100, then an annual fee for keeping the Leo Club active.

How do Leo Clubs receive certification?

Once you have 20 kids, aged 13 to 18, signed up, they need to elect their officers. You must submit a completed Leo Club Organization Report (Leo-51). Set up a Charter Installation, similar to Lions installations, making sure to invite the parents and school personnel, if you are school-based.



Leos to Lions?

Yes – once kids see what Lions do in their community, they will be interested in being a Lion. Their Lions member dues are at a discounted “student” rate, as long as they are in college and until age 30.
