SHOT RECORDS: All dogs must have current shots—especially rabies. Registrations without shot records will not be assigned a race until records are received. Current tags will not suffice.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

- Registration begins at 12:30 p.m., Sunday, April 30, 2023. This is a first-come, first-served process. All races are open for on-site registration the day of the event.
- Races are assigned in order of receipt of a complete registration packet (i.e. registration form, entry fee, and current dog shot record).
- You may bring your dog's favorite toy – however, it may not be larger than 8 inches.
- No food (human or dog food) or other pets are allowed in the race track area.
- All dogs must be on a leash – except when racing.
- Owners are required to clean up after their dogs.
- Dogs must be on their best behavior – no fighting, biting or aggressive behavior.
- Only one owner/handler allowed in the race track area at any time.
- No waving blankets or other large items at the start of the race.
- The first and second place dogs from each race will qualify for the finals.
- PRIZES: \$100 for first place; \$50 for second place; and \$25 for third place.
