- 7) **Appoint new members to a committee/project immediately.** Orient them either formally or informally. Discover their talent and use them to your club’s benefit. Listen to their ideas about service projects needed in your community.
- 8) **LCIF – 100 Club Goal:** Each club is asked to pledge a certain amount to LCIF for each year during a three year period. Just remember that LCIF donated \$9 million immediately after Hurricane Harvey. Texas Lions Foundation donated \$1 million. Support these two charities when able.
