One thing that seems an ongoing issue – communication – or lack thereof! I get so much information from International and from the Multiple District, but I have limited success in sharing with all the clubs because there may only be one email address listed for a club and the information doesn't go beyond that one person. We need an email account to send the invoices for MD and District Dues (and yes, you still have to pay them!) An example of a club email account could be "mylionsclub@gmail.com" or yahoo or Hotmail. The world is going digital faster than we may like, but the future is now in terms of communication. It isn't all bad, but it is a change for some of us!!.



It is not ideal to have a newsletter that has pages and pages AND pages of information – the content is important, but it is still difficult to read large documents on the computer screen and it is a pain to print off pages and pages. So, what I am going to try to do for the remainder of my year as your Governor, is to limit the pages of the newsletter by just having topics or subjects of concern or interest with the detail on our District website:
