One really interesting thing we did in DGE School that emphasizes the connection we have with Lions around the world was an exercise where we tried to solve some problems a fictional Lions club had – we worked through some options and then we met with a group of Japanese DGEs who had been working on the same problem. Now, I have to tell you, no one in my group spoke Japanese and no one in the Japanese group spoke English, and we started off quite hesitant. But with the help of the wonderful translators, we came to realize that we face the same challenges in keeping our clubs healthy, getting new members and serving. A smile and a sincere desire go a long way in communicating! There were about 19,000 Lions from around the world at the Convention and after our experience with the Japanese group, the recognition from the crowd during the parade, and the renewing of friendships from around the world, it reinforced my belief that we are one family, bonded together in our dedication to serve others.

This new Lionistic year, 2014-2015, will be like every other Lionistic year with the challenges of keeping our clubs strong, our members interested and dedicated, reaching out to new members, and serving our communities and those in need. We have an added challenge with preparing for the redistricting of our Multiple District. We can't do anything officially until the LCI Board makes a decision in October about our submitted plan – but we can think about what we like, what we don't and take advantage of this opportunity to build our District in a way that reflects what we want and who we are!




