District 14-B - Policy No. 303

Policy to Define the Duties of the District, State and International Conventions Chairperson

PURPOSE: To establish guidelines to help the "District, State and International Convention Chairperson" to act as a liaison between the State Convention Chairperson and the International Convention Chairperson,

GENERAL: The Chairperson shall serve the interests of the District and the Clubs by promoting better club and member participation in State and International Conventions, His specific responsibilities will be to:

- 1 Promote attendance of all Lions, Lionesses and Leos of District 14-B to the Multiple District 14 (State of Pennsylvania) Convention and the International Convention.
- 2 Advise the Lions, Lionesses and Leos throughout the District of any special activities at the state and International Conventions.
- 3 Advise all clubs and members of any information requested and how to:
 - A. Complete registration requirements
 - B. complete proper certification
 - C. obtain housing and/or camping facilities D.know of Business Sessions and of Caucus activities
- 4 Advise the Lions, Lionesses and Leos throughout the District of any issues to be voted upon at the State and International Conventions.
- 5 Encourage all Clubs to send a complete voting delegation to vote in the state and International Conventions.
- 6 Provide a report at the District Cabinet Meeting of activities, events and issues at the State and International Conventions and provide a report after the State and International Conventions of our District involvement.
