A c followed by a, o, or u would be pronounced "k." A c followed by an i or e is pronounced like "s." Similarly, a g followed by an a, o, or u would be pronounced like the g in "goat." They usually shake hands when introduced and when they leave, and they will stand to greet you if seated.* Note: In Spanish, questions and exclamations are "surrounded" by punctuation marks. Ustedes is the plural form of the word "you." Vosotros is the plural form of but it is rarely used except in Spain. In Mexico and many other Spanish-speaking countries, ustedes is used for the informal plural of "you." It is important to remember these distinctions in the case of introductions. When in doubt, use the formal form.* A formal introduction:Me gustaría presentar al Señor Rodríguez.*¡Buenos días! Good morning!¿Cómo está? How are you?Muy bien, gracias. Very well, thank you.¿Y usted? And you?* Note the use of (+) before the masculine title al señor. Use before a person's name and a la before a feminine title followed by a name.
