The Letters4 Pages are designed by Chris Trace, and there are several versions available to cater to different needs. One version helps students learn both uppercase and lowercase letters by practicing them side-by-side repeatedly, developing an association between the two forms. Another version removes the dot tracing scaffold while retaining horizontal handwriting lines, encouraging uniformity in letter size. For students who struggle with letter formation, such as writing 'e' backward, there's a version that repeats each letter, uppercase and lowercase, on a line. Once they've practiced tracing letters, you can move them to another version without the dot tracing scaffold but still using horizontal lines as a sizing guide. These versions focus specifically on capital or lowercase letters and even simple sight words starting with each letter of the alphabet, providing a structured approach to learning.
