NOTE: This guide is not compatible with console users, there is no LAN option available. Other than online play, you can choose Local which allows split-screen mode.LAN, also known as a Local Area Network is one of the multiplayer options that is available with Borderlands 3. What this does is allow you to play with other people who are on your network, whether this is on your home network or an online one using services such as Hamachi.One of the main advantages of LAN is it allows you to play multiplayer offline, as you arent connecting through online servers. Whilst enabling LAN can also be used to prevent other people from joining your game.Below, we have put together a short guide for joining a LAN server. To do that, open up the Main Menu (by pressing ESC on PC), then choose Social.LAN BrowserYou will be taken to the Roster screen where you can invite friends. Instead, we need to head to LAN Browser. Use the tabs at the top of the screen to go to the far right one which has a network icon. Borderlands 3 will open your game to LAN once you turn on Connect to LAN.ServersAny servers that can be joined will show up in this list. If your friends server isnt visible, make sure they have enabled LAN. They can do this by pressing the cogs icon in the top right corner of the screen and changing the privacy settings to LAN. Borderlands 3 is here, and if youre sensible, youre going to want to play this game with a few of your friends. When Gearbox Software announced the game, we all knew you were going to play Co-op, because whats a good Borderlands game if you cant do it? You can play online, but you can also play the game with your friends on the couch. Heres how you play it split-screen. How to Play Split Screen Co-op in Borderlands 3 When you start up the game, youre going to get the option to choose the difficulty. Pick the option you want, and then select if the game is going to be competitive or cooperative. The difference between these two is that when you choose competitive, you and your partner are not leveling together and youre going to be vying for the same ammo caches. You wont share it. Instead, youre going to rely on telling each other about the ammunition youre not using, and helping the other if theyre a lower level than you. Whereas with cooperative, youre going to stick close together, support each other, and then youre sharing ammunition and loot. After you start the game, youre going to see a brief cutscene, and youre going to watch the story of the game. This cutscene should only happen for the first couple of minutes, and then youre going to choose your character. If you have two controllers plugged in, your friend should have the chance to pick a character to play. Its important to note those playing on the PC are not going to have this option. PC players do not get split-screen mode with their game, only console players, Xbox One and PlayStation 4, are going to get this option. While it of course has upgraded visuals, features and more from this generation, it retains a lot of things from the earlier games that have fallen out of style in gaming circles. One thing Borderlands 3 fortunately keeps around is splitscreen co-op multiplayer. Heres how you can set it up to play with friends locally. You can play every second of Borderlands 3 with a friend either online, or via couch co-op with a buddy right next to you. You can play with four people online, but local gameplay is limited to two. Not surprising considered the screen would end up pretty sliced up with four people playing at once. To play splitscreen co-op local multiplayer in Borderlands 3, first make sure both players are logged in on their respective controllers. Even if they dont have their own paid membership, theyll need a free account set up in order to log into their profile and create their own character. After that, load up the main menu and then have player 2 press A on Xbox One or X if youre on PS4 to join. If they dont have a character created yet, they will need to create one. They can do that by selecting Load Character with their controller. The game will then prompt them to create a character, which they should do. Once thats done, you can Add Splitscreen from the Play menu. If its greyed out, that means its already activated and you can just go ahead and hit New Game or Continue depending on what you want to do. If its not greyed out, theres a good chance you didnt properly log everyone in prior to starting the game up. After that, youre all set. Borderlands 3 uses a neat level-sync feature which will ensure that everyone gets an appropriate amount of EXP and does normalized damage regardless of their characters level or mission progress. You can also play with the loot settings to make it cooperative (everyone gets the same loot) or Competition which retains the old greedy Borderlands ways.
