# Do animal cells have food vacuoles

Vacuoles are storage bubbles found in the cells. They are found in animals and plants, but they are much larger in vegetable cells. Vacuoles can store food or any variety of nutrients that a cell may need to survive. They can even store residual products so that the rest of the cell is protected against contamination. Eventually, these residual products would be shipped out of the cell. The structure of the vacuole is quite simple. There is a membrane that involves a mass of fluid. In this fluid are nutrients or substances. Plants can also use vacuoles to store water. These minor water bags help support the plant. They are closely related to objects called vesicles found throughout the cell. In the vegetable cells, the vacuoles are much larger than in the animal cells. When a vegetable cell stopped growing, usually there is a very large vacuole. Sometimes this vacuole can occupy more than half of the volume of the cell. The vacuole holds large amounts of water or food. It is not surprising that the vacuoles can also handle plant residues. These residues are slowly broken into small pieces that can not hurt the cell. Vacuoles hold things that a cell may need, like a backpack. Helping with support vacuoles also play an important role in plant structure. Plants use cell walls to provide structure and support cells. The size of this vacuole can still increase or decrease depending on how much water is present. The plant cells do not shrink because of the changes in the amount of cytoplasm. Most of the volume of a cell depends on the material in vacuoles. These vacuoles gain and lose water, depending on how much water is available for the plant. An inclined plant has lost much of its water and the vacuoles are shrinking. It still maintains its basic structure because of the cell walls.
