Catmint in winter

Warning: Can only detect less than 5000 charactersPinks (Dianthus Gratianopolitanus) is, these have evergreen foliage so just clean up the dead flower stems and any scruffy foliage in spring, after bloom. Coralbells (Heuchera) is, these have evergreen foliage so as to cut the flower derives to the basal foliage in the autumn and clean up the foliage in spring or according to needs. Save any hard pruning for spring early just before growth is displayed. Don't forget to always practice good garden toilets during pruning and cleaning your garden in winter. Also clean your holders regularly with rubbing alcohol or a bleach mixture and water so that you don't unintentionally spread any disease.
