Elden Ring has numerous areas to explore, including hidden gems like Mohgwyn Palace. Players need a special item from White-Faced Varre, an easily missed NPC, and complete his questline to reach this palace. This guide helps players prepare for the Shadow of the Erdtree DLC by showing two paths to Mohgwyn Palace. The path begins immediately after starting the game with White-Faced Varre's mysterious appearance and advice on reaching Stormveil Castle. However, returning to Varre after defeating Godrick and visiting Roundtable Hold reveals he has vanished, leaving a clue for players to find him at the Rose Church in Liurnia. At the ruined Rose Church in the swamps of Liurnia of the Lakes, Varre can be found outside, offering the Festering Bloody Finger item. This item allows players to invade other worlds and kill players for runes and Rune Arc. Using this item three times triggers the next stage of Varro's story. After completing this task, Varre asks players to anoint them as a "knight to serve Luminary Mohg" by performing another task: soaking a cloth called the "Lord of Blood's Favor" in blood from a Finger Maiden. Alternatively, players can progress Varre's Questline after receiving the Festering Bloody Finger by invading "Magnus the Beast Claw" at Writheblood Ruins. Defeating Magnus counts as all three invasions needed to advance Varre's quest and allows players to acquire the "Great Stars" weapon. The Church of Inhibition in Liurna contains a Finger Maiden whose blood can be used to complete Varre's request, making this method likely simpler than invading another player. The Church of Inhibition is protected by Festering Fingerprint Vyke, a formidable foe who wields Frenzied Flame Incantations and a Spear. While he's a force to be reckoned with, his attacks often have a telltale buildup that players can use to anticipate and dodge them. Alternatively, venturing to the Four Belfries in western Liurna allows players to activate a portal beneath the second Belfry, effectively teleporting them back to the Chapel of Anticipation at the game's beginning. Following this path, players can return to Varre after avenging the Grafted Scion and interact with him until he rewards the Pureblood Knight's Medal. This unique item enables players to instantly travel to Mohgwyn Palace, which is also accessible without it but requires searching for a hidden portal in the Consecrated Snowfields. The latter involves navigating through the Yelough Anix Tunnel, where encountering a Sanguine Noble with dual-wielded Reduvia knives poses a significant threat due to their swift and ranged attacks. By carefully observing their movements, players can overcome this challenge and proceed southwest toward Mohgwyn Palace's hidden entrance. Unlike other portals, this one is camouflaged in blood, dropping players into the Blood Swamp near the Mohgwyn Dynasty Mausoleum. From there, a perilous journey through the swamp awaits before reaching the Demigod within. In contrast to traditional Dark Souls games like Elden Ring, Mohgwyn Palace offers two unique entry points hidden deep beneath its map. Although it can be seen from Siofra with an ominous orange-red glow, only one early path and another secret area provide access to this intense region. Caution is advised against entering too soon, as the enemies within are scaled for the endgame and pack a formidable punch, including tougher versions of previous foes like crows in Caelid or cartwheeling alien creatures from Liurnia. The first of these paths is significantly easier and more accessible than its counterpart. The White-Faced Varré's questline offers players a method for permanent invasion and access to Mohgwyn Palace through the use of a medal. This quest is relatively short and can be completed after defeating Godrick the Grafted. In Liurnia, players can find White-Faced Varré at Rose Church on an island in the giant lake, west of the region. Speaking with him three times progresses the quest, while two additional conversations yield rewards such as a reusable Bloody Finger and the Pureblood's Knight Medal. To access Mohgwyn Palace, players have two options: either use the medal to teleport directly or complete the Haligtree Medallion by finishing Latenna's questline in Mountaintops of Giants. The latter requires completing the Haligtree Medallion using a Great Lift of Rold. Mohgwyn Palace is challenging, especially with its difficult boss, Mohg, whose second phase can be tough without special items and endgame stats. One notable aspect of exploring this area is the rune farming locations past the red lake, which offers various methods of farming runes. However, lower-level players may find it difficult to explore this area successfully. ###
