Curtain Let’s start with something simple: a curtain! If you’re looking to lay some permanent roots in Minecraft, a curtain (especially something this small) might not be the best option. Thanks to the proverbial bells and whistles this Minecraft construction got, it’s not even the fastest option, too. But if you have the resources to save and want something fresh, unique and functional? YouTuber Eystreem has one of the best tutorials to follow. Then grab a white wool and a rug, a couple of hooks three threads, some oak fences, a flashlight, and à of course à a bed. This is a fun and easy structure to get things started. P.S. Outdoor Kitchen Now that you have a place to sleep outside, why not expand on all the outdoor atmosphere/camping a bit more with an outdoor stove? This is a bit simpler than curtain as you don’t really need a lot of decorative stuff, but still requires a bit of ambush, angular, and block destruction get right. But we definitely consider it a beginner friendly Minecraft construction, since it does not need a lot of materials, either. Just a cauldron, a little cobbled stone, a flint flintsteel, charcoal blocks and a potion (for purely aesthetic reasons.) These are all elements that you can easily procure in survival. To build it, follow the same Eystreem tutorial!3. Picnic table You have a place to sleep and a place to cook. All you need now is a place to dine out – in style! Once again, Minecraft player and master builder Eystreem has a great tutorial for building a legit picnic table in Minecraft. He also has a bright red umbrella! You will need seven campfires, a shovel, a cobblestone (or any random block to use as scaffolding,) a spruce hatch, spruce signs, three armor, oak fences, pistons and spruce trigger devices (either lever or block) and four Red beds (for umbrella). The campfires will act like the seats while the spruce vents and signs will act like the rest of the table. The umbrella in the center is made using armor, oak fences, pistons and beds. Don’t forget to put out the fires using the shovel! This will leave you with, as Eystreem puts it, àààààbeautiful, rustic kind of trunk seat design that’s not going to burn your ass.ààTMFunctional Builds4. Bamboo Bridge This is a pretty impressive piece of architecture. It uses a lot of resources, but the results are incredibly worth it. I mean, look at it: This is an absolutely impressive construction to have for any suburban-overgrown-jungle type environment. It is definitely a bit more complicated than what outdoor camping builds, then. Get ready. Just know that you’ll need a lot of bamboo and bone meal, a couple of fires, some rabbits and leads (supplement!) fir fences, some sandstone stairs, and a shovel (to put out the campfires). As usual, this tutorial by Estreem lists everything you need with appropriate amounts, so don’t skip the tutorial notes! They also mention that you can build the bridge to be as long or as short as you need it to be, but it is recommended to do so 9 blocks in length to match their tutorial just to be on the safe side. Feel free to change the length and width once you get how the scheme works (and you can then scale it appropriately). The main trick is to plant the bamboo where you want the bridge to be, and then use the bone meal to skip the growth process. Technically you could wait for the bamboo to grow, but if time is of the essence, bone meal is a good hack. The amount of bone meal you are going to use for each stem is actually very specific and accurate (i.e., three bone meal for the first leg, four for the second leg, etc.) so pay close attention to the tutorial! Also, did you know that you can stop bamboo from growing just by putting piece of rope on top? Strange but absolutely useful for this Minecraft build!5. Trampoline Work Here’s another Minecraft build that isn’t as complicated as the bamboo deck, but definitely just as fun (and functional.) is an honest-good work trampoline, designed and built by another highly talented Minecraft Again Dude. As you can see in their tutorial, the trampoline is suspended a high block. Make sure to follow the frame template set so that the trampoline looks good as it works! The secret of this functional trampoline? Thin blocks covered with black carpet. Who would have thought, right?6. Racacar BedAlways wanted a fresh running bed? Make this dream a reality in Minecraft with a couple of quartz plates, quartz scales, red carpet, stone buttons, and à of course à a red bed. Eystreem has another helpful tutorial on how to make your Minecraft bed look like a high-powered red racacar, built for speed without compromising the usability of the real bed. This is one of those easiest Minecraft builds that you can probably store and recreate after a tryout.7. Elevator WorkingOkay, this is a bit of a doozy. We would put it right next to the bamboo deck in terms of difficulty, if only because there are control blocks and controls involved. But you will be pleased to know that the functional appearance is optional. If you just want a broken elevator to furnish your business facility, you can still follow WiederDude’s tutorial for materials and diagrams à ignore the bit with the control blocks. It starts with a white concrete frame 4x4 built in the ground and oak wood as a base. The rest of the elevator is made of white concrete columns, four-high, a solid white concrete wall, and glass panes for the left and right walls of the elevator. At the front of the elevator (or what is essentially going to be the door), just place a line of glass against the right side of the chassis. This will leave a void for your avatar to go in and out. The lift works thanks to a frame of the element inside the lift with a spectral arrow (up points) and a button on the front and a control block on the back. You will need to enter this command:/tp @p ~4~Build an exact replica of the elevator at the top of the existing elevator. The only difference will be the spectral arrow (indicating this time) and the command. For the second elevator, you will enter this command:/tp @p ~4~Don’t worry; the tutorial is much more detailed than that!8. Working TankThis working tank is one of Eystreem’s favorite Minecraft builds, and it’s not very hard to see why! You can actually sit in this tank and shoot harmful fire from it. Remember we wouldn’t classify this as a beginner’s construction, either. Just because there are a lot of resources to gather and a lot of strategic positioning and rotation. It is not as complicated as the elevator because you do not need to encode anything, but it is definitely a little longer. For this Minecraft construction, you will need: x2 fumatorix2 spruce wooden stairs x9 doors abetex3 grindstonesx64 (or any random block to use as scaffolding) x1 cauldronx1 water bucketx1 dye blackx2 grey capsx10 leather coatsx10 blind standx2 oak fences x2 pistonix1 pistonix1 activation device (red stone block or red stone lever) x6 podzol (or any ground block) x2 tripwire hooksx1 railx1 minecart1 dispenserx64 fire charge (or any explosive, such as TNT or arrows) x1 stone button Got it all? Then luck! The secret ingredients to this construction à ie the things that are going to make this a real work tank à are the cart, the distributor, the fire charges, and the stone buttons. The pistons, the oak fences, the railroad, the trespire hooks, the armor, the leather caps, and the dyeing are more decorative, but they still need to be positioned properly if you want the tank to look good! Be sure to check out the Eystreem tutorial for the complete step-by-stop process.9 Working Garage DoorThis is another Minecraft built by WiederDude, and will still require command blocks and coding. But if you compare this garage door working with the elevator working, this is definitely much more manageable for a first time builder and coder. Then you will use iron blocks to fill in the middle, essentially creating a wall 3x4 iron block. This is the garage door. As with the elevator, you can opt not to go through with the control blocks and the coding section if you just want a decorative construction. But if you want the door to go up and down like a real garage door, you’ll need specific coordinates and commands. The specific commands are:/fill [coordinates] air/fill [coordinates] iron block It is a bit difficult to explain which coordinates you will need and how to modify them accordingly to emulate a garage door, so pay close attention to the tutorial! If you don’t get the right coordinates and you don’t code it as instructed, the construction will definitely not work. Decorative Minecraft Builds10. Ceiling Fan Did you know that the pebble stone, an end pole, ropes, wooden planks, white carpet and an iron hatch could make a nice ceiling fan? Apparently, WiederDude did, and they show you how in this tutorial. This Minecraft construction is another option for beginners that is quite simple (in terms of lock) and does not require a lot of resources. The creator recommends using white carpet to make it look very contemporary and modern. Put it in a light oak room for a stylish and modern atmosphere! 11. Hanging Plants And speaking of modern minimalist, here’s a Minecraft built by Eystreem that would pair beautifully ceiling fan: plants hanging! According to their tutorial here, you’ll need 12 spruce doors, 2 polished andesite, 3 stone brick walls, 2 blocks of grass, 2 sweet berries, 2 bone meal, and 2 chains à just to name a few. It may seem a lot to just hang the plants, but we promise that the construction is worth it There’s some clever financier who goes on with the traps à more bone-meal-grown plants à but nothing too hard for new builders. 12. Japanese Box KiteTurn your outdoor space into a beautiful lantern party with Eystreem Japanese Box Kite! The trick to making it look like a real floating kite is à if you believe it à a deposited rabbit and some lead. It sounds crazy, but it really works! Chuck a soul lantern on top and experiment with colors and patterns for banners to create some stunning night decorations. Japanese Katana If you really liked the Japanese Kite Box, we’ll end this list with another Japanese-themed furniture item: a Japanese Katana. Whether your Minecraft avatar is a weapons collector or a famous sword master, this in-game katana (plus the sword stand!) is definitely a must-try among Minecraft constructions! You will need a couple of acacia wood slabs, armor, some striped acacia wood blocks, pistons and red stone, a frame, two red banners, four red dyes, six yellow dyes, a field brick banner pattern, a border indented banner pattern, 2 chains and a final bar. Follow the tutorial closely to see how Eystreem uses its “double piston system” to get the armor is going to look like a sword stand! And make sure you start building where you want to put the sword. Unlike a real decorative katana, this is pretty hard to move. As you can probably guess, the patterns of banners and dyes are purely for aesthetic reasons so you can change the colors and patterns as you want. But I will say that the patterns and colors that the creator suggests make the banners look very oriental, so maybe stick to their recommendations for now.
