The Jeep Cherokee has taken a hit in the US new car market, with sales sliding 20 percent last year from their 2018 levels, tumbling 30 percent year-over-year in the fourth quarter alone.To better align production with demand and avoid a glut of unsold Cherokees from amassing on dealer lots, Fiat Chrysler Automobiles' Belvidere Assembly Plant near Chicago will shut down for two weeks starting Monday, January 13th. The plant will idle through at least January 27th, when regular production will resume, according to Automotive News. Jeep Jeep Jeep The Cherokee is Belvidere Assembly's sole product, starting production there from 2017 after the last examples of the Dodge Dart, Jeep Patriot, and first-generation Jeep Compass rolled off the line. The plant employs nearly 3,700 hourly workers.Industry-wide, new car sales are down in the US market, but the Jeep Cherokee's sales slump far outpaces the industry average. The current fourth-generation Cherokee has been in production since the 2014 model year, receiving a mild facelift for 2019. The compact crossover is slated to receive new safety features later this year, according to a summary of the FCA's latest contract with the United Auto Workers union, but it's unknown when we'll see a complete redesign. Jeep Jeep Fiat Chrysler will also idle its Windsor Assembly Plant for the same span this month as both of its products - the Chrysler Pacifica and Dodge Grand Caravan minivan models - have seen a similar dip in demand. Pacifica sales slid 17 percent for the year, while demand for the Grand Caravan experienced a 19-percent drop.Overall, though, Fiat Chrysler sales were down a more modest 1.5 percent through 2019, in line with the industry average slump, as deliveries from the automaker's Ram Trucks division surged 18 percent to more than 703,000 units.Total Jeep brand sales in 2019 slid 5 percent in the US market as the all-new Jeep Gladiator joined America's expanding mid-size pickup segment. Chrysler Dodge Scott Olson/Getty Images News/Getty Images If you have a door with damage on your Jeep Grand Cherokee, you can remove the door to repair it or replace it. The hinges are welded to the body of the Jeep but the door half of the hinge bolts to the welded section. There are only four bolts to remove to separate the door from the Jeep's body. Open the door of your Jeep Grand Cherokee all the way, exposing the hinges between the door and the body. If your Jeep has power windows, door locks or speakers in the door, there will be a rubber boot running from the body to the door to protect the wiring. Slide the rubber boot back from the door, pulling the tab on the boot to free it from the door. Disconnect the wiring harness connectors by releasing the locking tabs and separating the two halves. Locate the four mounting bolts that secure the door side of the hinge to the body side of the hinge. The heads of the mounting bolts are inside the hinges toward the body so if the door is not all the way open; you will not be able to get a wrench on the bolts. Remove the four mounting bolts starting at the bottom and working your way up to the top bolts. The door is heavy and will drop when you remove the final bolt, so get a helper to assist you in steadying the door if possible. Remove the door from the Jeep and set it somewhere safe for now. If you are removing any of the other doors on your Grand Cherokee, repeat this process for each of them. Lowering the back seat in the Jeep Grand Cherokee opens the cargo space for larger items. In fact, the cargo space can almost double in capacity by flipping down the seats. The Jeep Grand Cherokee even features a 60/40 rear seat. The larger of the split seat backs is behind the driver's seat, while the smaller seat back is behind the passenger seat. This allows a single passenger in the back seat with the other half lowered for cargo storage, if needed. Open one of the backseat doors on the Grand Cherokee, and inspect the rear seat to ensure there are no articles in the seat that would prevent the seats from being folded down properly. Open the rear lift gate, and crawl into the cargo area. Remove the cargo cover, if needed. Older models require prying in a release tab on the right-hand side of the cover to release the cover from its pilot holes. Newer versions of the Grand Cherokee simply lift the retracted cover out of its cradle behind the rear seats. Locate the hinges on the outer-upper corners on each seat back. Lift the hinges upward to unlock the rear seat from its hinge anchor, and push the seat downward. Repeat for the opposite side to open the cargo space up to its full capacity. Pull the seat backs upward until the hinges lock onto the hinge anchors when ready to restore the rear seats to their original position. Replace the cargo cover, if needed, by reversing its removal procedure. Cars in general are notoriously finicky, but this doesn't mean that you have to take it lying down. Check for any and all factory recall notices. Jeep is required by law to contact you via mail when a recall for your vehicle has occurred, but in case that notice got lost along the way, go to Jeep.com, select "Grand Cherokee" under the "Select a Vehicle" tab, and check the recall notices (see Resources). Check your gas cap. If the "Check Engine" light on your Jeep Grand Cherokee's dash board has come on for what appears to be no reason at all, the first thing you should check is your gas cap. If you have built up any moisture under your gas cap, it could cause the "Check Engine" warning light to come on. Take a dry cloth and wipe the underside of the cap and then screw it back on securely. Restart your vehicle and see if the light comes back on. Do not fill your gas tank with cheap fuel. Jeep Grand Cherokees are notorious for not doing well with fuel with lower octane, especially during the winter months. Fill your Jeep with at least medium grade gasoline, especially if it has been shuddering or hesitating while you're attempting to accelerate. Change the fluid in your transmission and install a new transmission fluid filter. Jeep Grand Cherokees have a history of chewing up and spitting out transmission fluid on a pretty consistent basis. If your vehicle is giving you problems when trying to shift from one gear to another, this is almost certainly the cause of the problem. Expert Insurance Reviews reports that you'll pay an average of \$1156 for an annual policy for a 2010 Grand Cherokee, compared to \$1414 per year for the 2020 model.The website also stresses the importance of the driver's age in insurance coverage costs. On average, a 20-year-old driver will pay more than \$1730 per year more to insure a Jeep Grand Cherokee than a 30-year-old driver with the same make and model. Your policy price will go up if you have violations on your driving record; drivers in their teens and 20s will experience an especially steep increase for claims.High-risk drivers of all ages, defined as individuals with at-fault accidents and violations, pay an average of \$1600 to \$2300 per month for auto insurance. This represents a rate of up to 128 percent more than the average for a driver with a clean record.If you live in an urban area, you'll pay more for auto insurance than you would in a suburb or rural community. That's because insurance companies pay out more claims for customers in cities than they do for those who reside in less congested areas.The average cost may also vary dramatically based on the insurance laws in your state.
