How to fake a positive pregnancy test with apple juice

This April Fool’s Day many people will play a common prank on their friends, family, or significant other by pretending to be pregnant. While we don’t encourage this prank, we do wonder how it works. Two ways they do this are 1) use a fake pregnancy test that always turns positive, or 2) make a real pregnancy test turn positive without being pregnant. In this week’s post I set out to find out scientifically how these methods work. I also found a lot of other crazy stuff related to faking a pregancy, which is more common than I ever imagined. WARNING NOTE: This topic can be very triggering for women who have experienced struggles to conceive or pregnancy loss. If this is you, I am very sorry for your loss and encourage you to skip this article. Why do so many people want to fake pregnancy tests? First I must report a disturbing research finding: there are tons of other people researching how to fake a pregnancy test. But why? Part of me doesn’t want to know. Trapping a significant other using a fictional baby as collateral? Or maybe people are worried that are the ones being trapped, or even pranked? Either way, someone is watching too many soap operas. I used the nifty SEO tool keywords everywhere and found that thousands of people each month search Google for topics such as “fake pregnancy test results”, “fake pregnancy papers”, and “how to fake a pregnancy belly”. The basic question “how to fake a pregnancy test” is searched over 4,000 times per month. 90 people a month want to know how to fake a pregnancy test at the doctor’s office, which takes...huevos? More than 200 people a month search for the oddly specific “how to fake a pregnancy test with apple juice.” I’m not thirsty anymore. “Positive pregnancy test for sale,” bringing in roughly 390 searches a month, is another jaw-dropper. New side-job perhaps? Is this relevant to how fake pregnancy tests work? Absolutely not. Is it weird, interesting, and more than a bit creepy? Definitely. What makes a normal pregnancy test turn positive besides pregnancy? Real pregnancy tests work by detecting the hormone Human Chorionic Gonadotropin (hCG), which is only produced by pregnant women. When the test senses the hCG in urine, a line turns a color- usually pink or blue. More specifically: The tests work by binding the hCG hormone, from either blood or urine to an antibody and an indicator. The antibody will only bind to hCG; other hormones will not give a positive test result. The usual indicator is a pigment molecule, present in a line across a home pregnancy urine test.Thought Co (Unfortunately for the oblivious prank victim, many other chemicals besides hCG can make this test line change color. If something mimics the hormone, triggers the indicator, or damages the test, the results can be inaccurate. Soda is one of the most common ways people try to get a fake result on a real test. Juice reportedly does the trick (or at least hundreds of people think it does). And soap reportedly brings out that line. While writing this the scientist in me got inspired to test these theories out myself. I have a bunch of tests leftover from when we were trying to conceive our son, so I tried it out with three readily available beverages: diet coke, flavored sparkling water, and white wine. The results? Top-notch kitchen science, minus the lack of positive control (sorry, Mom!). Everything was negative! Maybe it needs to be regular Coke? Or there IS something magical about apple juice? But whatever’s in my fridge doesn’t do the trick. There are other ways to do it rather than chemically changing the line. You can draw the “positive” line your self. This must be a popular option because there’s even a wikHow article on how to DIY, with step-by-step illustrations. According to one site, heating the stick up may break down the antibodies that detect the hormone, giving a positive line. Or you could get a pregnant woman to pee on it for you (not sure how that conversation goes.) How do “fake” pregnancy tests work? Several companies offer fake pregnancy tests that always turn positive, even when the person peeing on a stick (it can even be a man) isn’t pregnant. One popular example is the Right Time test. It promises to turn positive whether or not you’re pregnant: you don’t even have to pee on it; even water will give you a “pregnant” result. But after way too much time trying to figure out how they work scientifically- though one could reasonably argue that any amount of time is too much for this task- I was coming up empty-handed. I did find this bit of information. According to the manufacturer: Using urine on the Test is not necessary because it was manufactured to turn positive using any liquid that is not too acidic.Right Time Pregnancy Tests Aha, a clue! It can’t be too acidic. So perhaps it’s a pH strip that’s triggered by any liquid above a certain pH. This is clearly different from coaxing a fake result from a real test, since that reportedly can be accomplished using soda, which is extremely acidic. Fun fact: regular water has a pH of 7 and battery acid has a pH of 1. Where does Coke fall? About a 2.5! This prank is not only potentially emotionally costly, it’s pricey. They sell for a minimum of ~\$10. And in case the test itself isn’t costly “proof” enough, you can also splurge on customized fake pregnancy documents. So while the science I was able to dig up on how these tests work was vague at best, one thing was clear: other pranks will probably be less costly and funnier. Simply hold the absorbent Color Change Tip in your urine stream, or in a sample of your urine collected in a clean dry container, for just 5 seconds.
