Above all memories of your faithful service to God, your kindness towards others, etc - what kind Have you been a creation of recent memories? Love for the family, brothers, friends ... 1. Loving reports take time to develop 2. Don't just think of your family, you could survive all yours; Remember brothers and friends - What kind of relationships with the people who are developing right now? D. The Word of God ... 1. It also takes time to acquire familiarity with the Word of God 2. To find out who to contact to find comfort, peace, and strength - you are familiar to become familiar The bible so that can help you in your pain? E. prayer ... 1. Prayer is valuable only if we are just relationships with God - 1Pe 3:12 2. Prayer is comforting only if we are already close to God - you are approaching God frequently talking to him in prayer ? F. Songs ... 1. Like the Word of God, the songs comforted us when we are familiar to us 2. When we had time to reflect, to understand what we are singing - pretty spiritual songs finds comfort in them now? Conclusion 1. The death of a right person is precious in the view of God - PSA 116: 15 c. The loved one is finally returned home; If we remain faithful, the separation will be temporary 2. The blessings that God offers to the sons of him in time of death are so many ... a. But they must be received and acted on b. Do we need to act now to benefit from them in the future. There will be not Christians in the crowd and believers who need comfort and security from God. If you are a layperson, an initial shepherd or an experienced shepherd who wants to do something a little different, this is for you. I will lay out in the form of a side dish and give some examples. My suggestion is to be relaxed, confident, do not preach a sermon "ellfireÅ ç å,~", but to talk to the whole congregation as if it were a person. Be gentle and real.
