Reader Beware, You're in for a Scare! Goosebumps is a children's horror book franchise published by Scholastic Corporation. Th books are written by author and creator R.L. Stine. It is currently the second best selling book series of all time, selling 400 million books worldwide in over thirty-two languages. At one pint the franchise was the #1 best selling book series of all time, selling over 4 million books a month during its prime. Beginning with the eponymous Goosebumps series in 1992, the Goosebumps franchise has spawned numerous follow-up and spin-off series. The franchise's other forms of media include a television series and feature films. The serie is named after R.L. Stine had seen an ad for "Goose Bumps Week," a television horror event. The name is also based on the skin condition goose bumps, which is a common syptom of fright.The iconic Star Wars franchise embarked on a cinematic journey with the release of its groundbreaking space opera, crafted by George Lucas's masterful pen and direction. This pivotal moment marked the beginning of a monumental phenomenon that would go on to captivate audiences for decades, generating a staggering multi-billion dollar empire. Beyond the silver screen, the rich tapestry of the expanded universe continued to unfold, with novels, comics, role-playing games, and other media weaving intricate stories that further enriched the cosmos. Interestingly, the first novel in this series premiered 6 months prior to the debut film, effectively making it the elder statesman within the franchise's narrative chronology. In a significant development, Disney acquired the rights to the Star Wars intellectual property in 2014, designating everything produced before that date (excluding films) as "Legends" and all subsequent content as "Canon." This collection carefully lists both Legends and Canon entries separately, charting their respective courses within the in-universe timeline. Both timelines utilize the pivotal "Battle of Yavin" from A New Hope as a reference point to differentiate events, with BBY denoting time periods before this event and ABY signifying those that follow it.Users can conveniently access or borrow books by checking if the bar under the cover says "Borrow" or "Read."
