It’s that assertiveness that makes it sound good in this autumn-themed cocktail, where it combines with lemon, maple syrup and fresh pear. Modern English comes from Michael Waterhouse, a long-time barman and bar consultant in New York City. The drink has a unique approach to its construction. A gin sour like a pear flavored Gimlet is not unheard of, but generally it means freshly squeezed lemon juice, simple syrup and some kind of pear liqueur or pear syrup. Instead, Waterhouse uses lemon slices, maple syrup and a slice of pear, all mixed with Bulldog gin. Thanks to global markets and imported goods, it is possible to make drink at any time of the year. While the Western literary canon is expanding to include, and elevate, stories outside of which white readers, Western readers have dubbed “the classics”, there are still some works that tip over in every student’s career, from Frankenstein and the epic of Gilgamesh to Amato and the Great Gatsby. So why literature is important a –” and why do we study it? Merriam-Webster defines literature as poetry or prose that has “excellence in form or expression and expresses ideas of permanent or universal interest.” While it may seem like a tantura to say, the world’s greatest works of literature have changed minds, unleashed rebellions and helped change the course of history. While it would be impossible to contain all the contributions and multitudes of literature here, we will take a look at some of the landmark moments in the history of this art form. Like other recovered art objects, literature has the power to tell us about ancient civilizations. Not only can we understand their customs, values and lives, but we can get a better idea of what seemed to be their entertainment. The earliest examples of literature can be traced back to ancient Mesopotamia. Around 3400 BC, the Sumerians developed a writing system called Cuneiform, which allowed scribes to record myths, hymns, and poems. Even today, Gilgamesh is considered the first first masterpiece of world literature. Indeed, much of the Bible parallels this ancient work, further emphasizing how universal and influential Gilgamesh was and continues to be. In 375 B.C. Plato, the Athenian philosopher, wrote The Republic, a dialogue between Socrates and his Greek colleagues that explores challenging questions of justice, order, and the just man. And around the 8th century BC, the historical periods attributed to the poet Homer, the Odyssey and the Iliad helped to preserve Greek mythology and history in writing. In the beginning, literature was enclosed in poetry and drama, after all, the theatrical performance was another great source of entertainment. During the 11th century, or Heian period, Murasaki Shikibu wrote The Tale of Genji, considered by many scholars to be the first modern novel. The four protagonists of Journey to the West. Photo Courtesy: Wikipedia Years later, in Europe, things began to change significantly in the wake of Geoffrey Chaucer’s The Canterbury Tales, a collection of 24 stories written in Middle English between 1387 and 1400. Taking the prose torch around 1485, Thomas Malory published Arthur’s Death, one of the first novels of the Western canon. During the Renaissance, writers like Molière began to make satire on everything, from the Church and government to society at large, demonstrating that written works had a propensity to shift the balance of power and to rethink one’s view of the world. During the 16th century, also known as the Ming Dynasty, the Chinese novel Journey to the West was published. Attributed to Wu ChengkeAjien, this work rich in satire and allegory is considered one of the Four Great Classical Novels of Chinese literature. During the same period, William Shakespeare helped lay the foundations of modern English and to create the literary tropes and narrative formats we still cherish today. And, of course, in 1615 Miguel de Cervantes wrote Don Quixote, a romantic and archetypal novel that is considered one of the most influential works of all time. Again, it is impossible to fully summarize the breadth of literary history here. In addition, this article focuses on written works, but it is important to note that many cultures and groups of people record their stories through the imaginary instead of “handing down their stories through oral traditions”. All of this to say, our view of literature is narrow and, in many ways, limited by the way institutions educate people. have shaped our understanding of what is important. Photo Courtesy: Brad Barket/Getty Images James Simpson, head of the of English University of Harvard, talked about these limitations directly in an open letter to the Wall Street Journal Journal For Simpson, the old Western literary canon, which highlights the literary contributions of white men (and often straight), “transmit the fundamental function of literature and other forms of art, which is to hear voices repressed by official forms of a given culture”. Of course, the literary canon has been refreshed in the past, which shows that it is important to reshape and rethink the stories we consider essential. For example, at the time of his writing The Scarlet letter of Nathaniel Hawthorne was a sort of scandalous (easily consumable) history similar to HBO of the day. But, now, it is largely considered an essential and probatory work — not only entertainment. In the wake of World War I, authors such as Virginia Woolf and F. Scott Fitzgerald wrote novels, such as Mrs. Dalloway and The Great Gatsby, who captured their disillusionment first of all. However, these continue to be unreliable reading works due to the way in which they exemplify handcraft and narrative elements. (At least in part.) The most modern literature has also come out in the most formal notion of literary subgenres, ranging from science fiction — a genre created by the author Frankenstein Mary Shelley — to romance, fantasy and realism. Retracing some tropes, conventions and fonts, the genre helps us to understand how particular stories are shaped by classifying them. Without a doubt, literature helps us to discover — whether it is a discovery of the past, a present self, or a possible future. The most distinguished literary writers, such as Toni Morrison, Alice Walker, Margaret Atwood, James Baldwin, Kazuo Ishiguro, Chinua Achebe, Jhumpa Lahiri, Gabriel Garcia Marquez, Zadie Smith and Maggie Nelson (and many other people who do not have the space for the name!), capture all these facets. In short, climbing into the mind of other characters and worlds — in moving away from ourselves — literature allows us to understand universal truths; change the mind; mix empathy; and express our identity and values in lasting and far-sighted ways. ways.
